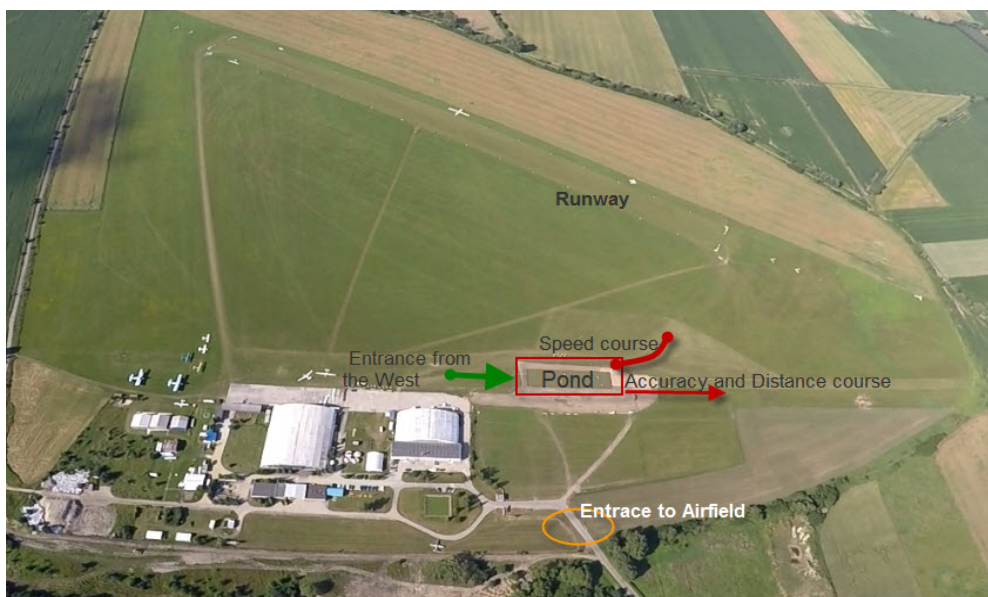

Liability insurance coverage to third parties for the event is provided by the organizer.
Any damage to hotel rooms or third party claims is the responsibility of the persons involved.
Personal items and equipment are the responsibility of the owner/user.

15 Visa information

Visas for EU/EEA citizens:
