Safety Issues



- **Safety first: Do not get hurt!**
- After landing (stop), leave course!
- On problems: Use alternate landing areas (no swooping on reserve)
- No flying over spectators (tribune side)
- No unsafe behaviours (= hazards to others or yourself!)
- Bail-out areas: On judges tent side multiple, on spectator side along the course (keep it free)
- Watch for Obstacles: Laser, Windsock, ... Marked with orange boye, red/white tape
- Watch for approaches on the way back (stay close to the fence)



Closing course



- Smoke at entry gate area (on land).
- Orange (large) flags waiving (flat) near entry gate.
- Do not land in the course (use airfield)
- If you are close fly carefully in the most clear area and land there. Watch out for persons and ambulance.

Venue





Schedule



- Intended schedule has been published. That schedule may change (as it already has).

Course



- Windmeter at course, display visible from both sides of the course. Type: Ultrasonic. 15. min history.
- Windsock at course on judges side of the pond
- Streamer: Multiple streamers / small windsocks available.
- Distance and Zone Accuracy to E
- Speed to E, left carve into N
- Freestyle: Judges/Spectators S, Landing areas: E and W. Carve to N on both sides.

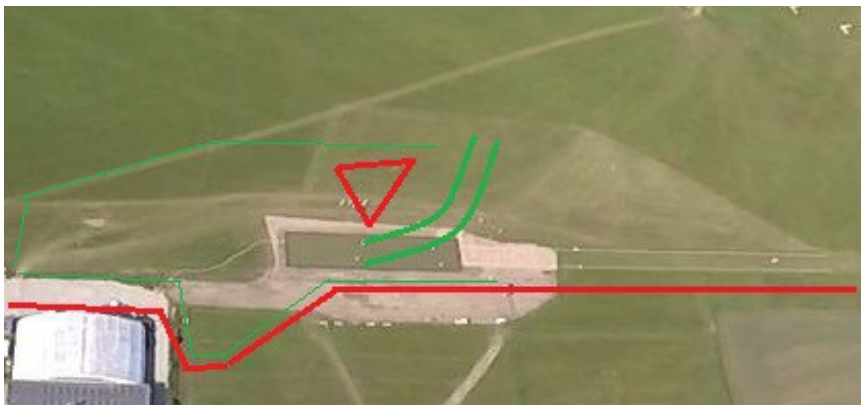

Exit Order



- Exit order was published and you have filled in your exit order already. If not complete we will call the missing passes at the end of the meeting.
[everybody will get 2 helm numbers (both sides) and harness numbers (right side) for your container at the end of this meeting]
- If you have different exit orders in different disciplines, make a clear statement.
- CJ must be informed about exit order changes. If you tell Manifest, make sure they relay it. (MD will).
- Please try to give 20 sec. between jumpers to enter the course.
- The scale is available at Manifest (digital, 1 decimal)



Aircraft



- 2 PAC (15 jumpers = 3 passes with 5 exits)
- 1 C206 (up to 6 jumpers) [for rejump]
- Dropping Altitude
 - 5 per pass: 1750m (others according CR CP 2018)
- Exit Speed: 80kt
- Calls: 15 min call & 5 min call = boarding
- Boarding Area: At line of flags behind main tent
- Pilot signals: (check red light before exit again)
2min (red), 1min (white): Door open, Exit (green)



Rejumps



- Receive the rejump form from CJ (EJ)
- Get ready as soon as possible
- See manifest to get a slot for your rejump
- Pay attention to your calls, it may be fast.
- If there are more than one rejumper on the pass, make sure you have sorted your exit order and tell CJ or MD (via Manifest).

If we continue with next round, you may continue jumping in normal order and do the missing jump at the end. However your first jump will be your first round, the second your second round and the third jump your third round. Independently of what round the others are doing at that time.
